As the British withdrew, a once peaceful land erupted into communal violence; 14 million people were forced to flee homes they had lived in for generations, causing the largest forced migration in history. - came to live in Britain to restart their family lives. To many of the second and third generations of those families, their ancestor's experiences in this turbulent time remain completely unknown.
